



Chuck Sanders enlisted in the US Navy in 1977, then volunteered for Submarine Duty. From 1979 to 1990 he served on one Polaris and two Trident Submarines in total making seven Strategic Deterrent Patrols in the Pacific where he earned his eligibility to join the VFW family. Chuck joined the VFW as a Member at Large in 2012. In 2015, he transferred his membership to VFW Post 6514 Osage Beach Missouri. Post members have seen his leadership skills and as a result he has held the positions of Trustee, Jr. Vice Commander, Sr. Vice Commander, and Commander. In which the post has earned All-State honors five times and All-American honors four times under his tenure. During his time as Commander, he took the achievements and leadership skills to District 2,
