1. The Winter Council of Administration Meeting and Voice of Democracy, Patriots Pen, and Teacher of the Year Banquet will be held on February 20 thru 22, 2026 at the Resort at Lake of the Ozarks, 3076 Bagnell Dam Blvd, Lake Ozark MO.65049 . All members of the Council, as well as Committee and Chairpersons, should make every effort to attend and be prepared to report in accordance with the agenda. Room reservations may be made by calling the hotel at 573-693-9988. The form for banquet tickets is attached.
2. The 2026 Department Convention will be held at the Oasis Hotel & Convention Center , Springfield, Missouri, June 11th thru June14th, 2026. Reservations for rooms will become available on **February 23**. Currently, reservations are restricted to a three (3) day stay and may be made by calling the hotel directly at 1-888-532-4338, Be sure to let them know you are with the VFW. Persons reserving three (3) days and later cancelling one (1) or two (2) will have the entire three (3) days cancelled. We do have an Overflow Hotel if Oasis is full or for anyone wanting to make a reservation for LESS than three (3) days, the hotel is: Holiday Inn & Suites of Springfield and may be reached at 417-865-8600.
3. Post and District Commanders should be reviewing the All-State program and know where you need to work on to meet the requirements. **The program changes each year, so don't just assume you know the requirements.** District and Post All-State requirements are listed in the District/Post Commander handbook. **To qualify, all requirements, except membership goal, must be met and recorded at Department Headquarters by April 30.** In addition, this is the last Council of Administration meeting that maybe attended to achieve All-State prior to our Convention. The attendance requirement may be achieved at the last CofA meeting during convention. However, the All-State award will be presented at the first CofA in the 2026/2027 year.
4. The Veteran Service Officer Program is vital to our organization. Donations from Posts, Auxiliaries, and individuals on a continuing basis are critical to this program. Without your donations, we cannot continue to provide the service we are now providing and this program is what we are about. Remember, our Service Officers are employed by you, the VFW members in Missouri to assist your members and Veterans in your community in obtaining vital health care and VA benefits. **The State Commander's expectation is that every Post donate a minimum of \$3.00 per member.**
5. If your Post has not made a donation to the Veterans Service Officer Program or the Veteran and Military Support Program, please do so ASAP. These are requirements for your

Post to earn All-State. **REMEMBER:** VSO checks must be mailed to Department HQs and VMS donations must be made online at vfw.org.

6. I want to call your attention to the following section of the National By-Laws and Manual of Procedure. Any Post not in compliance is subject to suspension.

Sec. 709 - Control of Units - "Any Post owning and/or operating, directly or by reason of a holding company or other entity substantially controlled by the Post or its members, a canteen, clubroom or other facility available to members or guests must maintain general liability insurance, including, if necessary or appropriate, liquor liability insurance. **Such insurance must be of a type and amount sufficient to protect the Post and must name, as additional insured's, the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States and the Department in which such Post is located. Post shall ensure policies purchased include these additional insured statements.**

If the Liability and Dram Insurance Blocks on the State Dashboard are **RED** it means we do not have a "Certificate of Insurance" on file for your Post, or it has expired. Please forward a copy, or have your agent send a copy, to Department ASAP. You can mail to 3401 Knipp Dr. Jefferson City, MO. 65109 or email to adj@movfw.org or hqangela@vfwmo.org.

7. Posts are reminded that **ALL** Officer Changes must be reported to Department and National. You can email a copy of the Officer Change Form to adj@movfw.org or hqangela@movfw.org you can also mail a copy to 3401 Knipp Dr, Jefferson City, MO 65109.

8. Section 105 of the National By-Laws is clear on Members in Good Standing in the Post. Members that have not paid their 2026 dues by their expiration date are not in good standing until the dues are paid. Section 220 of the National By-Laws states, "Any elected Post Officer removed by the Department Commander, by reason of failure to pay current dues ---shall not be eligible to serve in any Post office in the same administrative year in which the officer is removed". **Post Commanders and Quartermasters are encouraged to check their rosters and make sure their officers renew on time. For the next Quarter, We have 24 Posts with a total of 40 Officer's Dues Expiring prior to May 1, 2026.** This information will be included in the District Commanders packets at the Winter C of A.

9. The Voice of Democracy and Patriots Pen Scholarship program needs your support. Department needs Posts, Districts, and Auxiliaries to donate to cover these scholarships. Besides helping the kids, there are some good incentives to donate. Please see attached flyer.

10. The 2025-26 Membership Campaign is now underway. As of today, January 26, 2026, the Dept. of MO is at 96.47%. Now is the time to start calling your Annual Members to check on them and urge them to renew as soon as possible. Commanders need to scrub their Officer list and get them to renew their membership. Just like when we were in the Military, our Leaders should be setting the example for our members. Headquarters runs a membership incentive monthly. Watch your email or go on vfw.org for information.

11. Anyone requesting a Department Officer to attend a function must submit a **written request** to Department Headquarters at least 30 days prior to the date of the function. An e-mail to the Adjutant at adj@movfw.org is acceptable.

12. The deadline for submitting bids for the 2028 Department Convention is March 15, 2026, as prescribed by the Department By-Laws. Any Post or group of Posts wishing to submit a bid should contact Department Headquarters for the Convention hotel requirements and

coordination of the bid request.
