**(To be read or distributed at a regular Post meeting and filed)**

1. The 2023 Department Convention will be held at the Oasis Hotel & Convention Center, Springfield, Missouri, June 8 – June 11, 2023. Reservations for sleeping rooms became available on February 1. Currently, sleeping room reservations are restricted to a three (3) day stay and may be made by calling the hotel direct at 1-888-532-4338 or clicking the link on the attached flyer. Be sure to let them know you are with the VFW. Persons reserving three (3) days and later cancelling one (1) or two (2) will have the entire three (3) days cancelled. We do have an Overflow Hotel if Oasis is full or for anyone wanting to make a reservation for LESS than three (3) days, the hotel is: Holiday Inn & Suites of Springfield and can be reached at 417-865-8600. There are several other Hotels nearby. Attached is a Tentative Agenda and some information from the Springfield Convention & Visitors Bureau.
2. A meeting of the Council of Administration will be held in the Oasis Hotel & Convention Center, Springfield, Missouri, at 5 pm. on June 8, 2023. All business of the current administration will be concluded at that time.
3. All Department Officers, District Commanders, and Committee Chairmen are reminded that they are to submit a written report to the State Adjutant covering their activities of the past year. This report may be forwarded directly to Department Headquarters or given to the State Adjutant after arrival at the Convention. These reports will be made an official part of the Convention minutes. This report should be concise and cover the highlights of the 2021 - 2022 year.
4. The 124th VFW National Convention will be held July 22-27, 2023, at the Phoenix Convention Center in Phoenix, Arizona. Please go to the VFW website at [vfw.org/convention](http://vfw.org/convention) for general convention information including the registration form and links to other convention related information, including a tentative agenda.
5. Attention of Post Commanders is directed to Section 222 of the National Bylaws and the Manual of Procedure, which provides that each Post will pay, in advance, a National Convention registration fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25) which shall entitle the Post to a packet of convention information and materials and one identified registered delegate for the National Convention. Each additional delegate attending the National Convention will pay a ten-dollar (\$10) delegate fee. Posts are encouraged to register their Post delegate(s) online through the Online Membership System (OMS) or by submitting their National Convention Post and Delegate Registration form that is being mailed to all Post. **Post Quartermasters, please send in the \$25.00 registration fee and register at least one (1) delegate as soon as you receive the registration forms. Don't wait until July to send in your delegate fee.**

6. **Post Quartermasters**, you should have received a letter in early April concerning your Voting Strength and Delegate Dues owed. **Dues must be paid in order to vote at the Convention.** Don't wait to pay your dues at the convention. To help ensure a smooth election process please submit a check to Department Headquarters immediately to avoid last minute chaos and confusion. Checks for Delegate Dues will not be accepted at Convention Registration.

7. If you have not submitted a Post Election form, please do so ASAP. Post-Election Report Forms were mailed to Post Quartermasters with instructions that they complete the form online through the Online Membership System (OMS) or they can complete the form and return directly to National Headquarters **immediately following** the election of Post Officers but not later than June 1, 2023. **Posts that do not submit an election report will be put on suspension.** If you need help, please call Dept. Headquarters.

8. Newly elected District and Post Officers do not assume their duties until June 11, 2023.

9. The Dept. of MO. reached 100% in Membership on May 21. A big THANK YOU to everyone who worked so hard to get us here. Ten (10) entries will be drawn for around \$355 each after the All-State Ceremony at the State Convention. So, keep working on membership. You're Post could win more than once.

10. Commander Royce Kelb sends Congratulations to all of the Post Commanders and Quartermasters that achieved All-State for the 2022-2023 year. Forty-Six (46) Posts have achieved this Honor and will be receiving White Hats at the Awards Ceremony Friday Evening at the Awards Ceremony. If your Posts met all the criteria except membership by May 1. You can still make All-State if you reach 100% + 1 by June 30. You will receive your White Hat at the Fall C of A.

11. Mark your calendar for Friday, September 29, 2023. There will be a Charity Golf Tournament benefiting the VFW National Home. The event will be held at the Bear Creek Golf Course in St Charles, MO. Please see attached Flyer for more details and to register.

12. District Commanders, you are encouraged to get your District Meeting schedule for the 2023/2024 year put together as soon as possible. Please send a copy to Department so a complete schedule can be put together for the State Officers. When putting your schedule together keep these dates in mind. September 22 and 23, 2023 Fall C of A, October 20 & 21, 2023 Big 10 Conference, and February 9 & 10, 2024 Winter C of A.

13. **REMINDER:** In order to vote at the Department Convention, you must stop by the Registration Table and register prior to 11 am on Saturday morning. Also, Post Delegate Dues must be paid, all four (4) Quarterly Trustee Audits submitted, and the Post Election Report submitted. To avoid chaos and confusion these items will not be accepted at Convention Registration. If any of these items are missing, your Post will not be allowed to vote in the Election.
